



GET 'REDI' TO HELP SAVE LIVES THROUGH VHA'S RESUSCITATION EDUCATION INITIATIVE

The Resuscitation Education Initiative is VHA's national program to standardize, document, track and monitor the provision of Advanced Cardiac Life Support, Basic Life Support and Advanced Trauma Life Support training throughout VHA. REdI is a business unit within the Simulation Learning Education and Research Network. It provides critical train-the-trainer clinical training support using American Heart Association guidelines to provide training to large numbers of VA medical center clinical and non-clinical employees.

REdI is a VHA health care transformation initiative under the New Models of Care Specialty Care Operating Plan. The goals of the REdI Program are to expand the number of employees certified in ACLS/BLS/ATLS over time, in order to advance the quality of patient care and to improve the documentation for resuscitation training.

The REdI program is co-located within the SimLEARN National Center in Orlando, Fla. The program is developing national resuscitation training policy and curricula, and is also purchasing equipment for distribution to VHA facilities that affiliate with the REdI National Training Center.
